



YOAKUM CLEAN UP PROGRAM

Time for the City of Yoakum Semiannual Cleanup Program. During the FIRST week of April, the following services will be offered in an effort to assist local residents in making Yoakum a better place to live, work and play:

Free residential bulk item pick-up is still on track for the week of April 1st through April 5th

In addition to regular garbage pickup, City crews will pick up any large items placed at the curbside for its current residential customers. **Items must be placed at the customer's place of residence near the curbside location for regular garbage pickup.** Vacant house, vacant lots, and commercial properties will not be served. Items will not be picked up outside the City limits of Yoakum.

Items must be at the curb on Monday, April 1st.

For your convenience, the Solid Waste Management Facility will be open on Saturday, April 6th, from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM for Yoakum citizens with valid utility bills.

Regular household garbage, commercial tires, appliances with refrigerants, paint and hazardous waste **WILL NOT** be picked up. Commercial tires, paint and hazardous waste **CAN NOT** be accepted at the Solid Waste Transfer Station. A limit of four (4) tires per household will be accepted.

There is no need to call for pick up services.

Limbs, brush & yard waste will **NOT** be picked up in coordination with the Clean-Up Event; these will be picked up with the City's normal chipping/yard waste routes.

As a reminder, the Solid Waste Management Facility is open Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM, and on Wednesdays from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM (closed from 12:00-1:00) and is also open each Saturday from 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM. Citizens are allowed to dump permitted items **FREE OF CHARGE** with the presentation of a City of Yoakum utility bill. Appliances (without refrigerants), furniture, computers and computer accessories are accepted

Citizen volunteers are asked to join in for a trash collection effort throughout Yoakum in an effort to beautify our community. Organizations wishing to participate in the Clean Up Program through this method may contact City Hall between 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM for location coordination and equipment (grabbers, trash bags, etc.) to assist with the effort.
