POSITION:

Fire/EMT (Basic, Intermediate, OR Paramedic)

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

Basic - Conduct fire suppression and ambulance services; administer first aid and other life saving skills as qualified; protect property from fire-related damages as much as possible; inspect buildings for preplanning operations in case of fire; maintain all equipment and facilities in good working condition; maintain and continually improve skills as necessary and/or required to accomplish assigned duties; assume the duties and responsibilities of engineers when necessary; perform fire safety and prevention activities; and assist in coordinating EMS efforts with other departments, agencies, and general public.

Intermediate – All duties as indicated above for basic officer and provide prompt and efficient patient care before transport to the hospital or other medical facility; provide as needed advanced life support interventions; and provide safe and efficient transport and continuous care, while enroute to the hospital or other medical facility.

Paramedic – All duties as indicated above for basic and intermediate officers and act as on scene EMS supervisor for all emergency calls in the absence of the Fire/EMS Director.

OPENING IN:

Fire/EMS Department

QUALIFICATIONS:

Basic – High school diploma or equivalent; certified in Texas as Firefighter with an EMT-B or higher, EMS certification; valid Texas drivers license with B classification; must live within a 10 minute response time.

Intermediate – All qualifications as indicated above for basic officer and certified in Texas as Firefighter with an Intermediate, or higher, EMS certification.

Paramedic – All qualifications as indicated above for basic and intermediate officers and certified in Texas as Firefighter with Paramedic EMS certification.

RESIDENCY:

All Fire/EMS Employees are required to live within 10 minutes of the Fire Station.
