All **entry forms MUST be turned in on or before 6:00 p.m. on November 17th**. This will ensure that we have space available to display your project. Entry forms may also be emailed to librarian@cityofyoakum.org by this date.

Projects MUST be turned in by 6:00 p.m. on November 27th.

No late entries will be accepted.

Categories: Kids (ages 5-8); Pre-Teens (Ages 9-12); Teens (Ages 13-17); Adults/Families; and Organizations/Businesses.

All participants will receive a treat and certificate, and the top rated projects by our judges in each of the categories will receive a fantastic prize donated by DeWitt Poth & Son.

Judging will take place on November 29th; and will be based on craftsmanship, composition, creativity, and completeness. Winners will be contacted after this date.

Create your favorite Christmas story using edible materials!

All components **MUST** be edible and delivered on a sturdy display base (*base does not have to be of edible material*). Each project must clearly display a theme/title/scenery of a Christmas book (examples: A Christmas Carol, The Nutcracker, How the Grinch Stole Christmas, etc.). The title of the book **MUST** be on your project and visible. **Please use ingredients that will hold up through December 31st**. Suggestions may be gingerbread, crunchy cookies, pretzels, candy, icing that hardens, rice crispy treats, etc. Please do not use cake or liquids.

The Library display opens to the public on December 1st. Participants are asked to leave their projects at the library through December 31st as part of the library's Christmas display.

Individuals may pick up their projects during the week of January 2, 2017.

Those not picked up during this week will be disposed of.
