Summer Reading Program

Summer is a time that all children should read more than ever in order to prevent “summer learning loss”. Don’t fall behind in your reading this summer, join our “Build A Better World” reading program!

1. Come by the library beginning June 1st TO pick up your reading log AND keep track of all the books you read over the summer. If you fill up the log, please pick up a new one so that you may add to your list. Please keep all logs together and turn them in at the same time.
2. **Write your name, age, & library card # on the log. This information will be used to identify the child participating in the program.**
3. Children reading 10 books during the month of June will receive a FREE ADMISSION pass to Splashway Waterpark – this pass is only good for 1 child admission, ages 5-11, during the month of June. Must present reading log at the library in order to receive pass.
4. Bring your reading log with you to each visit. ***For every 5 books read, participating children will receive a prize.***
5. Participating children must read within their age range/reading level (*for example if the child is age 10, a board book for a baby is probably not appropriate*).
6. Books such as a look and find do not qualify as they are considered an activity book.
7. All logs are due no later than Friday, July 21st by 6:00 p.m. so that we may tally the results in order to award prizes.
8. Prizes will be awarded to children reading the most books in the following categories:
 - a. Category No. 1 – Ages 2-5
 - b. Category No. 2 – Ages 6-9
 - c. Category No. 3 – Ages 10-13
 - d. Category No. 4 – Ages 14-17
