Materials Not Accepted at Facility

- i. Any material classified as hazardous material.
- ii. Liquid waste of any type or amount (except waste motor oil that can be recycled).
- iii. Ashes, in any amount, including barrels with burned trash.
- iv. Concrete, rocks, or dirt.
- v. Special waste as defined in Section 1. Prohibited Waste, Item b) unless listed in Section 10. Solid Waste Management Facility, Item c) Recycle Material Accepted at Facility.

Recycle Material Accepted at Facility

- i. Dry corrugated cardboard (no cereal boxes, etc.)
- ii. Computer paper
- iii. Metal, including household metal/tin cans, aluminum cans, aluminum, copper, brass, and other scrap iron.
- iv. Plastic bottles, types 1 & 2.
- v. Newspapers, newspaper advertisement inserts, and magazines. Materials must not be yellowed and must have been published within the past 90 days.
- vi. Non-Commercial waste motor oil and filters.
- vii. Appliances that DO NOT contain refrigerants, or CFC's. Certifications showing CFC's have been removed and disposed of in compliance with State & Federal Law must be presented to the facility attendant.
