DECLARING A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the City of Yoakum has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to protect the health and safety of the citizens of Yoakum, and to ensure assistance for continued vital services for our community; and

WHEREAS, the extraordinary winter storm that has affected the entire State of Texas beginning on February 12, 2021 created extreme hardships for its citizens; and

WHEREAS, beginning February 12, 2021, Texas communities were faced with rolling blackouts, water shortages, impassable roadways, property damage, and potentially deadly drops in temperatures; and

WHEREAS, schools, universities, and other governmental entities altered their schedules, and some venues were temporarily closed, as precautionary responses to the unusually extreme cold temperatures in Texas; and

WHEREAS, costs incurred beginning Friday, February 12, 2021 to prepare for and respond to these weather conditions, power outages, and water issues have begun to mount at the State and local levels; and

WHEREAS, the City of Yoakum has taken numerous steps to recuperate from a portion of the devastating effects of the storm, including the replacement and repair of water well pumps, replacement of electric transformers damaged by the ice, snow and weighted limbs, as well, as increased manpower for maintenance crews on duty 24/7 to ensure power and water were restored as timely as possible; and

WHEREAS, it is critical to take additional steps to prepare for, respond to, and mitigate the effects of these types of events to protect the health and welfare of Texans in the future; and

WHEREAS, continuing the declaration of state of disaster will facilitate and expedite the use and deployment of resources to enhance preparedness and response; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Texas Governor has declared a State wide disaster in response to the severe winter weather; and

WHEREAS, the governor of the State of Texas, the Honorable Greg Abbott, preemptively declared a state of disaster in the State of Texas in response to the severe winter weather by and through a Proclamation attached hereto; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANITA R. RODRIGUEZ, Mayor of the City of Yoakum, on February 17, 2021 had certified that the severe winter weather storm beginning Friday, February 12, 2021 posed an imminent threat of disaster. In accordance with the authority vested in me by Section 418.108 of the Texas Government Code, I had declared a state of disaster for the City of Yoakum, Texas; AND, the City of Yoakum City Council met on February 24, 2021 in Special Session and voted unanimously to renew the declaration of disaster through the later of Friday, February 26, 2021 or 24-hours after the boil water notice is lifted, certifying:

1. That a state of disaster is declared for City of Yoakum, DeWitt and Lavaca County, Texas pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.

3. Pursuant §418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code this declaration of a state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City of Yoakum City Clerk and the Texas Division fo Emergency Management.

4. Pursuant §418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code this declaration of a state of disaster continues the City of Yoakum Emergency Management Plan.

5. This Proclamation shall take effect immediately and after its execution.

PROCLAMATION

BY THE

Governor of the State of Texas

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, GREG ABBOTT, Governor of the State of Texas, do hereby certify that severe winter weather poses an imminent threat of widespread and severe property damage, injury, and loss of life due to prolonged freezing temperatures, heavy snow, and freezing rain statewide.

THEREFORE, in accordance with the authority vested in me by Section 418.014 of the Texas Government Code, I do hereby declare a state of disaster in all 254 counties based on the existence of such threat.

Pursuant to Section 418.017 of the code, I authorize the use of all available resources of state government and of political subdivisions that are reasonably necessary to cope with this disaster.

Pursuant to Section 418.016 of the code, any regulatory statute prescribing the procedures for conduct of state business or any order or rule of a state agency that would in any way prevent, hinder, or delay necessary action in coping with this disaster shall be suspended upon written approval of the Office of the Governor. However, to the extent that the enforcement of any state statute or administrative rule regarding contracting or procurement would impede any state agency's emergency response that is necessary to protect life or property threatened by this declared disaster, I hereby authorize the suspension of such statutes and rules for the duration of this declared disaster.

In accordance with the statutory requirements, copies of this proclamation shall be filed with the applicable authorities.
