Crewperson I, Equipment Operator I or II

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

Crewperson I: Operate required equipment such as tractors, trencher, sweeper; perform minor equipment maintenance and repair; drive all trucks and equipment perform a variety of work assignments; perform other duties as assigned; subject to 24 hr. recall.
Equipment Operator I & II: In addition to Crewperson I: Operate heavy equipment such as front-end loaders, graders, or heavy trenching machines. Cut and fill to rough grade; perform minor equipment repairs; supervise crewmen and laborers in a work crew; drive all trucks and equipment; instruct other employees in the safe and proper operation of equipment.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Crewperson I: Demonstrated ability to perform all related manual tasks. One- year work experience in public works related field. Valid Texas Class B Commercial Driver License.

Equipment Operator I: In addition to Crewperson I: Ability to operate most equipment used in the public works and utility department, ability to perform all manual tasks in the public works and utility department, Two-years work experience in public works or related field.

Equipment Operator II: In addition to Equipment Operator I: Ability to operate all machinery used in public works and utility operations, ability to perform all manual tasks in public works and utility department, Three-years work experience in public works or related field, complete City approved supervisor training.
